Application Instructions

- ▶ The 2011 Patron Scholarship Application form must be completed electronically using Adobe Acrobat and not hand written. Completely fill in all fields. Once you have completed the document you must print it out, sign it and have your parent or legal guardian sign the application.
- ▶ All applications must be filled in completely. In the event that any required information is missing, every reasonable effort will be made to contact the applicant prior to the decision deadline.
- ▶ If more space is needed, please attach a separate sheet of paper with the necessary information, clearly indicating in which application section it belongs.
- ▶ **All applications must include the following additional information attached to the form:**
 1. **Official high school transcript that includes your first semester senior-year grades and your cumulative grade point average**
 2. **Copy of SAT or ACT scores (copy of mailed score report or web-based report is acceptable)**
 3. **Essay**
- ▶ Applications may be dropped in the box outside the door of the R.E. building, delivered in person to the church office during normal business hours, or mailed to the church. Applications that are not mailed must be delivered in a sealed envelope marked "Men's Club Patron Scholarship". Mail completed applications to:

- ▶ All applications must be **received** by the close of business on **Friday, April 1, 2011**. *Applications postmarked before this date, but received after April 1 cannot be considered.*
- ▶ **The Scholarship Committee will interview finalists on Sunday, May 1st between 1pm and 5pm.** Finalists will be notified of interview times no later than Monday, April 25, 2011. **Finalists not available on Sunday, May 1st between 1pm and 5pm will forfeit their opportunity to be interviewed.**
- ▶ The scholarship winners will be notified by May 5th, and will be officially recognized during a dinner held in conjunction with the Men's Club meeting on Thursday, May 12, 2011.

Catholic Church of Saint Monica Patron Scholarship

▶ **Eligibility**

The Catholic Church of Saint Monica Patron Scholarship is open only to active, registered members of the Catholic Church of Saint Monica. Applicants must graduate from high school in 2011 and attend an accredited college or university in the Fall of 2011.

- ▶ The Catholic Church of Saint Monica Patron Scholarship program is funded by the Men's Club, with contributions from members of the parish, or "patrons", and is administered by the Men's Club.
- ▶ The Men's Club Board of Directors serves as the scholarship review committee, with input from the parish clergy & staff. Winners are chosen based upon a combination of their academic achievement, extracurricular activities, involvement in the parish community, service to the local community, a written essay and an interview. We seek to recognize well-rounded, faith-filled students who represent the best of the youth of our parish.
- ▶ For 2011, several scholarships will be awarded, each in the amount of \$1,000.

- ▶ All applications must be filled in completely. In the event that any required information is missing, every reasonable effort will be made to contact the applicant prior to the decision deadline.
